## Join the New Energy-Efficiency Revolution to help out your Neighbors: Volunteer to Weatherize Low-income Homes

Did you know that nearly a third of U.S. households struggle to afford their energy bills, with one in five cutting back on or foregoing necessities such as food or medicine to pay for electricity and heat (according to the U.S. Energy Information Administration)? With funding from the City of Asheville and Buncombe County, Duke Energy, grants, and private donations, Energy Savers Network is working to restore the climate while improving the lives of limited-income households who struggle with rising energy costs. By training volunteers to implement simple but effective energy-efficiency upgrades to low-income homes, we can help our fellow neighbors/community to save money on their energy bills AND provide more comfort to residents during the cold winter and hot summer months. If your neighborhood is interested in volunteering with us, we promise they will enjoy learning new skills, putting a grateful smile on someone's face, and help to protect the health of this beautiful planet.

Most volunteer workdays are Tuesday-Friday from 9:30am - 1 or 2 pm depending on whether you work on a Housing Authority Project or the ESN Client Workdays - see our [Event Calendar](#). The tasks that volunteers will learn consists of insulating water heaters, sealing air leaks and air ducts, installing low-flow water fixtures, weatherstripping doors, replacing light bulbs, replacing single-use air filters with reusable ones, and building custom interior storm windows. We welcome groups or individuals who can commit to once or twice a month for a specific amount of time, and we do have COVID protocols in place (N95 masks, air filters, social distancing) to keep all our volunteers safe with low risk.
